The data Barnardo's records about you

Barnardo's holds personal information about you which may include your name, date of birth, address, gender, ethnicity, sexual identity and whether you have a disability. We will also record information about the service provided to you, including assessments, plans and reviews.

In addition

Barnardo's PATHS® Programme for Schools

records the following information

*Teacher and pupil surveys;
Training evaluation forms;
Feedback from parents, teachers, pupils and principals.*

Data that is shared from schools is anonymised before it is forwarded to Barnardo's and we do not hold identifiable personal data on school pupils.
