## **Safety**

Please make sure the gate to the nursery is closed as you leave to help us ensure the security of the children. If we are fortunate to have sunny days, please apply sun protection to your child before they come to nursery. If you want they staff to re-apply this you must put a bottle of sun cream in to their bag clearly labelled with your child's name. Sun hats and sunglasses are also recommended. We ask that children do not bring food into the nursery. We want to minimise the risk to children with allergies so ask that you keep any home time treats until you are out of the nursery building. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter but we are sure you agree that the children's safety is of paramount importance.

## **Keeping us up to date**

Please ensure you keep us informed of any changes to health or circumstances. If you are not picking your child up from nursery yourself, please inform us and ensure the person collecting has knowledge of the password we ask you to give when completing your child's plan. We are sure you will understand why these measures are in place to ensure your child's safety. Please make sure you tell us if you change address or phone number.

## **Donations**

Parents often choose to make a weekly donation of £3 to cover the costs of items such as snacks, special craft materials, cleaning resources and towards buying treats for the children at special times of the year such as Christmas and Easter. Without the donations, we would be unable to provide such a wide range of resources to enhance learning. Apart from milk and a limited supply of fruit, we have no other source from which to provide our daily healthy snacks so we very much value these donations from parents/carers. We ask that you pay on Mondays where possible. Some parents have expressed a wish to pay termly in advance. If you wish to do so, £24 will cover until our October holiday for those children who have attended since the start of term. Many thanks for your continued support. Due to covid 19 parents are unable to post their money envelope in the box in the cloakroom. We, therefore, ask that you put your donation in an envelope with your child's name on it and hand it to the staff member who welcomes your child in the morning. Thank you for your support with this.

## **Clothing**

Nursery uniform sweatshirts and polo-shirts are still available to purchase from the school office.

Please label all items of clothing and bags. If your child can't tie their laces we ask that the shoes are slip or Velcro!

## **Nursery Garden**

If you are available to give up some time to help maintain the nursery garden it would be very much appreciated. Please speak to nursery staff if you think you can spare a few hours.
