## NCCT

## Reporting - Work Home Programme

Again this session we will send your child's work home with them, throughout the year, to allow you to see how your child is progressing and to provide you with a further opportunity to discuss their learning with them. Starting in Term 2 we will send home your child's work from a selected curriculum area. We hope you will find this helpful and will enjoy looking at your child's work. There will be an opportunity for yourself and/or your child to comment on the work sent home however, should you not wish to comment, a signature is all that is required. If you feel that, as a result of looking at your child's work, you would like to discuss any aspect of your child's progress then please do not hesitate to get in touch with the class teacher. To allow this programme to work effectively and safely at this time, we will send work home on a Wednesday and must ask that you return your child's work to us by the Friday. We thank you in advance for your support with this.

## Appointments during school time

Parents are asked to arrange dental appointments etc. out with school hours. If children do have dental or other appointments during the school day a note should be brought to school indicating the time the child has to leave. Children will only be allowed to leave the building with a responsible adult for safety reasons.
