Drop Off/Pick Up Times

Please ensure that you stick to your child's pick up and drop off times. Yellow group should be dropped off at 8:40am and collected at 2:40pm. Blue and Green groups should be dropped off at 8:50am and collected at 2:50pm. Red and Purple groups should be dropped off at 9am and collected at 3pm. Red and Green groups are currently in the gym hall and the Yellow, Blue and Purple groups are in the main ELCC building. If you are running late please take your child to either the main school entrance or ELCC building depending what group your child is in.

In a safe and enabling outdoor space children will also explore risk, developing an understanding of their own capabilities.

Donations

Parents often choose to make a weekly donation of £3 to cover the costs of items such as snacks, special craft materials, cleaning resources and towards buying treats for the children at special times of the year such as Christmas and Easter. Without the donations, we would be unable to provide such a wide range of resources to enhance learning. Apart from milk and a limited supply of fruit, we have no other source from which to provide our daily healthy snacks so we very much value these donations from parents/carers. We ask that you pay on Mondays where possible. Some parents have expressed a wish to pay termly in advance and this is also possible. Thank you for your support.

Parentpay

We are now live on parentpay and whilst there are no trips planned at the moment, any future trips would need to be paid through parentpay as we will no longer be accepting cash for this. The weekly donation is different because it is a donation. We can accept cash for this and therefore have not set up the weekly donation on parentpay. Once you have registered this crosses over to the school once your child moves to Primary 1 so you only have to do this once.
