#### West College visit

On December 18<sup>th</sup> Primary 7 will be visiting the Paisley campus of West College Scotland to work with STEM ambassadors on a variety of science activities. The session will focus on density. The pupils will experience a range of 'hands on' experiments involving creating solutions of differing density and using food colouring to observe different layers of density within the samples. We are sure they will have a great time learning about science through these practical activities.

#### Antisocial Behaviour talks

Renfrewshire Council Youth Team will be delivering Antisocial Behaviour talks to Primary 7 pupils again this year. Officers provide age-appropriate essential information on how young people should behave to avoid negative consequences. Issues such as bullying, respect for neighbours and community, vandalism, graffiti, fires and litter are all discussed. The interactive chat helps pupils to understand the wider impacts of antisocial behaviour and what it could mean for their future, and their families. They will visit our Primary 7's on 15th January 2024.


