- > separate bag.


#### Homework

- Phonics (reading and writing) maths and mental maths.
- Also class discussions, active maths games, mental maths, reading and reflective reading activities, health booklet, word boxes, spellings.
- Homework handed out on a Monday. To be returned by Friday to be marked.
- ▶ Blue folder will be kept in class on Friday but diary sent home for communication.

- End of month review the target and comment on how they did.
- Award for specific children.

## Reading



#### How this works in class

- Picture books- handle books, turn pages, learn about pic cues.
- Story world-repetition, read & point left to right, sentence building, word boxes.
- ► After Stage 2 will use running records to assess whether they can go straight to stage 3 or above.
- Teach strategies to enable children to read independently. Time on task.
- Reflective reading to show deeper understanding, write answers on back.
