Golden Time

- If a class or school rule is broken then their name is moved to yellow to indicate loss of 5 mins.
 - Given two warnings.
- If a child continues then they are moved to red – loss of 10 mins.
- Complete loss of Golden Time due to extreme behaviour e.g. physical violence.
