Home Learning

During our time away from school you can use your home learning pack to support with your ongoing education. We will be prioritising literacy, numeracy, health & wellbeing and progressing as planned.

Teachers will continue to communicate with pupils and families through seesaw and glow. Please note if teachers are asking children to complete workbooks or textbooks they will post this directly to you through seesaw/glow of how and when to use these.

You can share any of your completed activities on your seesaw page by using your home learning code (contained within the pack).

Many formerly 'pay to use' educational websites are offering free trials to support school closures. A list of suggested useful websites to support learning will be provided by the class teacher, again through seesaw and/or glow.

Glow

All pupils have their own glow account. Their usernames and passwords can be found at the front/back of their school diaries (P1 will be posted on seesaw). This gives you access to educational sites such as books for all. It also allows pupils to access Microsoft office. All classes are connected to google classrooms which the class teacher may also decide to use. A how to guide will be posted on seesaw to help everyone access google classrooms if required.



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Seesaw

Seesaw will be used as the main tool for pupils to share their learning from home. Teachers may also set activities and learning suggestions through glow platforms e.g glow email, google classrooms.

P3-7 Accelerated Reading

Children who are already registered to use accelerated reading programme in school can still participate from home. They can check any books they are reading to see if it is listed as an AR book and thus take the related quiz as usual. The quizzes are a good indicator of how well a child has comprehended what they have read.

To do this you can Google Search "Book Finder" or select www.arbookfind.co.uk, click on student, type in name of book and it will bring up the information. *Please be careful to check it is the correct version of the book before taking the quiz.*
