As current guidance does not let us run our normal 'Meet the Teacher' event, class teachers will post video messages/presentation on Wednesday 2 September. If you have any questions you would like the teacher to answer, just send a Seesaw message and the teacher will respond during the post.

Parentsportal - You should have recently received information about Parentsportal, an exciting new initiative which aims to provide better communication between parents and schools. This is designed to replace the 'schoolbag run', giving parents online access to a range of school related services. If you have not already done so, please create your account asap.
