Dear Parents and Carers,

It with great pleasure that I welcome all of our pupils back to school! It feels great to have our community together again, although things may look a little different for a while. The health and safety of our pupils is always something we take seriously and so I thank our families for supporting us during this time. The boys and girls have worked so hard to follow the rules, keeping everyone safe by doing so.

Some parents/carers continue to raise concerns about the number of people waiting at the school gates and the lack of available space to maintain appropriate distancing. We recognise this and continue to find ways to safely manage the exit of pupils from the building. Calling Infant Classes forward in turn seems to be working well however should concerns continue we may have to look at alternative procedures. We respectfully ask that the number of adults at the school gates is kept to a minimum where possible, as this maximises the space we have available.

We will be sending out links to one of two questionnaires on our website. These have been designed to gather your views on all things related to lockdown and our return to school. Could these questionnaires be completed **no later than Tuesday 1 September** so that your views are collated, and we can act upon any concerns raised.

We have been trialling the reorganisation of our playground in order to prevent mixing between classes as per Scottish Government and Local Authority guidelines. These procedures have been explained to pupils who are managing this temporary change very well. As soon as we are able to let them mix more freely we will let you know. Please remember that we welcome your opinions, comments and feedback as it helps us to improve so drop us a line, pick up the phone or even come in for a visit. We always love to see you!
