Physical Education Update

Dear Parents and Carers,

I wanted to provide you with an update on the delivery of Physical Education (PE) within the school as outlined by recent Scottish Government Guidance.

- Children can now participate in both contact and non-contact activities indoors and outdoors.
- Classes will now use either the gym hall or playground for PE. If there is inclement weather PE will take place in the gym hall.
- Children should wear their PE kit on the days when they have PE lessons and wait until they get home to change.
- Staff and pupils will wash their hands before and after the lesson.
- Teachers will talk through the route into the gym hall and the health and safety measures to be followed during the lesson with the pupils.
- The teacher will work from a space that ensures they are 2m from pupils and will wear a mask if working out with this area whilst helping children.
- Any equipment that is used will be cleaned between classes.
- Children will be given the chance to feedback on how well protocols are being followed and how they could be improved.
- The gym hall will undergo a deep clean over the next 2 days prior to its use.
