## **Fundraising**

As you will know, our wonderful Parent Council is supporting the school with the purchase of a new Trim Trail. Our combined efforts so far are as follows:

Christmas Jumper Day	£127.50 (shared with Save the Children)

Our Parent Council are applying for a local authority fund of around £5000, and we will let you know the outcome of this.

The local tannery will be working with pupils on the creation of keyrings which we will be selling as part of an enterprise topic.

This provides us with a fund of around £9000 which will cover the cost of a new Trim Trail. Several companies have been approached to provide us with possible plans and ideas and we will be meeting these companies to find out more. Members of our Parent and Pupil Councils will be part of these meetings to ensure that all voices are represented.
