Cyber Scotland Week is 27 February – 5 March. We feel that staying safe online is an important life skill and so we regularly teach our pupils about the importance of staying safe online throughout the year. Our pupils learn about some of the aspects of CR-IS (Cyber Resilience and Internet Safety), including the importance of not sharing personal information and what to do if they have. We have run parent/carer workshops in the past but feel it is important that these things are revisited frequently for the safety of our pupils.
