Staffing Update

Whole School Trip

Our school trip this year will be to 'Heads of Ayr Farm Park' on Tuesday 13th June. From Tuesday 9th May your child's consent form will be available via parent pay for completion. We will be leaving school at 9.15am and arrive approximately 10.30am at the Farm Park. We will depart the farm park at 3pm and return to school approximately at 4.15pm. Your child's class teacher will provide further details nearer the time.

Primary 7 Hoodies

Our Primary 7 children can wear their Leaver's hoodies as often as they would like from Monday 15th May. The hoodies should be worn over formal school uniform.

Primary 7 Residential Trip

Primary 7 will soon be going on their residential trip to Lockerbie Manor House. They will be departing on Monday 19th June and returning on Friday 23rd June. Mrs Festorazzi will be supporting the children from Monday to Friday, I will be supporting the first part of the week (Mon – Wed) and Mrs Rodger will be supporting the end of the week (Wed – Fri). Primary 7 Induction Days for Park Mains High School

Park Mains transition programme is as follows.

9 th May	9.30am – 2.15pm	P7 children will visit a variety of subject departments throughout the day. They should wear full school uniform and bring their snack and lunch.
23 rd May	1.15pm – 2.30pm	P7 children will change into PE kit before leaving primary school to participate in PE activities at PMHS.
15 th June 16 th June	8.50 – 3.40pm 8.50 – 2.50pm	P7 children to attend a two-day experience. All children will follow S1 timetable on both days. Transport arrangements for induction days are the same as you have arranged for August e.g. children who stay in Dargavel should travel on the school bus from Dargavel. On these days children should bring their snack and lunch, PE Kit, bottle of water, pen and pencil.

I know the children are really looking forward to these days, please be reassured that they will receive lots of support as they take this next step in their learning journey.

Primary 1 Transition

We look forward to welcoming our new primary 1 children for their transition events, please look out for a letter which has been posted to you detailing all the events we have planned.

Our formal Induction Days will be on 15th and 16th June at 1.30pm at the school. During these visits the children will be with their class teacher becoming familiar with their learning environment and starting to build friendships. For our parents you will be provided with information to support your child starting school, the learning your child will undertake, you will hear from our partnership agencies and also from some of our senior pupils who will tell you about their experience of being a Langbank pupil.

Ms Steven's will be our primary 1 teacher next session and I know she is very much looking forward to supporting the children through this very important transition period.

School Improvement

During the Summer holiday the current Primary 5 classroom floor will be upgraded along with new storage for classroom resources.

Also, during the summer holidays 'Street Connect' a local Charity have offered to paint our school fence as it is very much needing a coat of paint. The fence will be painted green.

Thank you to Langbank Parent Partnership who have been successful in their bid for funding from the Community Climate fund. I know from our recent survey, improvement of our school grounds is something you would like to see and I am pleased we will be able to use this funding for improvement. The money will be used for playground markings which our children have chosen, it will also be used to improve the quiet area at the front of the school building, we intend to make this a sensory garden. Please keep an eye over the next few months to see the improvements.

Looking ahead to Next Year 2023-24

When we return after the summer holiday, I would like to request that you provide your child with a pair of indoor shoes that they can change into when they enter the school building. The reason behind this is that, in as much as we are fortunate to have such lovely school grounds, when the children are outside playing and re-enter the school the classroom floors can get muddy. I am conscious that our children often use the floor during learning experiences, so I would prefer to keep the floors as clean as possible. If you can provide your child with a pair of outdoor school shoes and a pair of indoor trainers/sandshoes, they will be kept in a gym bag on their peg and will also be used during PE times.

I appreciate your support with this.
