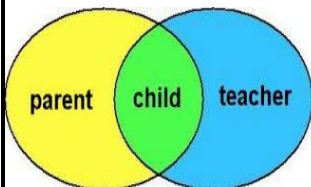
Dear Parent/Guardian,

## Open Afternoon for Parents
