# **Learning and Teaching**

As mentioned previously, although pupils have been developing their skills and knowledge through various curricular areas, there has been a specific focus on Literacy and Numeracy these first couple of months in an attempt to close any gaps which have been identified in learning. We have organised a support for learning programme across the school which involves additional staff working with small groups in an attempt to help pupils progress towards their expected levels.
