Last Day of School

P.E

As you are aware, due to level 4 restrictions, P.E. requires to be undertaken outdoors until instructed otherwise. As the guidance changes regularly, we recommend that children are equipped for all scenarios and come to school with their gym kit (for indoors) and warm, waterproof coat (for outdoors). During inclement weather, P.E. will not take place.

On the **14**th **December**, we will be having a Christmas fun day for all the children.
