RETURN OF P4-P7 PUPILS TO SCHOOL

Following the First Minister's announcement that **P4-P7 pupils will return to school on Monday 15th March**, I would like to add a little more detail to the letters which you will have received from Steven Quinn recently.

To help reduce congestion, we will still be operating a staggered drop off and pick up system, as we did prior to the Christmas holidays. Pupils should use the exact same doors as before and a reminder of the start finish/times are as follows:

Class	Start of day	End of day
P4/5, P6 & P7	8.50am	2.50pm
P4 & P5	9.00am	3.00pm
P6/7	9.10am	3.10pm

Please be reminded that all adults should wear a face mask in the school grounds and please keep a 2 metre distance from other adults when dropping off/waiting to collect your child.

Pupils should wear their school uniform and bring in any home learning work which they have been using during the lockdown period. Any laptops which have been lent by the school should also be returned. A school lunch will be provided each day, but pupils are welcome to bring a packed lunch if they prefer. Pupils will be encouraged to wash their hands frequently throughout the day and school furniture and resources will be cleaned regularly. Pupils will work and eat their lunch in their class bubbles within their classroom/lunch hall but may mix with their peers outside in the playground i.e. all P6 & P7 pupils will play in zone 1 while P4 & P5 pupils will play in zone 2.

The staff are all looking forward to having our P4-P7 pupils back at school, but we all realise what an unsettled time this has been for them. Therefore, our focus in the first week or so will be the health and wellbeing of our pupils and addressing any worries or anxieties which they may understandably have as they get used to getting back into the routine of attending school.

Teachers will also be assessing where every pupil is in terms of their learning and establishing plans to address the needs of each pupil going forward, with the main focus being on Mathematics, Reading and Writing. Teachers will let you know their plans for homework and provide you with an information letter in due course.

Please note that remote learning work will have been set for this week as normal but as teachers are planning for the return of pupils to the classroom, they will be unavailable for marking/feedback or live google meets this Friday.
