1. Connect Update

Information has been emailed to Parent Council members regarding the insurance with Zurich. It requires the Key Contact for the parent council group to be updated. 2. Parent Council Budget

5. **ECO Award**

Mrs Murphy has been working hard with pupils to attain the school's 4th Green Flag Eco Award. Mrs Murphy has been taking small groups of pupils up the Gleniffer Braes to participate in activities such as compass work.

6. **AOCB**: Traffic Congestion

Laura Pattison advised that an email had been sent to Renfrewshire Council's Safer Schools in relation to the traffic congestion around the school.
