Dear Parent,


Below is an outline of what your child will be learning about this term. Be assured, that over the course of the school year, pupils will cover the requisite range of skills and experiences and outcomes appropriate to their particular stage.

Mathematics

We will be working on improving mental arithmetic, so it would be great if you could practise and reinforce the number bonds to 20 at home. It would also be useful to practise time and money as these can be difficult for children

The practical maths this term will be taught by Ms Callery on a Wednesday.

Language

The Primary 2s will continue to work through Nelson Red Spelling. Initially working on CVC words then moving on to consonant blends.

The Primary 3s will be working on Nelson Yellow Spelling, using vowel digraphs and magic e.

In writing this term all children are being encouraged to improve the quality of their writing. We will be using a mixture of paired and individual work for this. The children will be encouraged to read over their



work and improve it by up-levelling. We will work on trying to increase the quantity of our writing as well as focusing on reading over our own and others' work to help spot mistakes.

We will be continuing with using the core reading scheme this term, however we will be carrying our reading for information related to our topic and also carrying out a novel study.
