# **Covid Update**

Following recent Government guidelines on the lifting of various restrictions in society, below is a summary of how some of these changes impact our school:

- Staggered drop off/pick up times will cease and normal 9.00am-3.00pm times will resume on Monday 21st March.
- Class bubbles have stopped and activities such as paired reading and mixed seating in the lunch hall will once again resume.
- Transition visits for pupils (i.e. nursery/P1 & P7/secondary) will be able to take place in Term 3.
- Health week can now take place, week beginning Monday 23/5, which will also include Sports Day on Tuesday 24/5.
- School trips will resume and these are already being organised by teachers and
  office staff. Please note that there will be no charge for any trip, as we will use our
  Pupil Equity Fund (PEF) money to pay for all our pupils.
- Our parent/teacher meetings, where staff and parents meet in the gym hall, will not take place this session but we will provide the opportunity for you to receive a telephone call from your child's class teacher and these will be scheduled for Term 3.

#### **P7 Activities**

As our P7s enter their final few months at Langcraigs, we are all so pleased that the easing of restrictions will allow some of our usual end of term activities to take place. Bearing in mind that covid has not disappeared completely, we have decided that ceilidh dancing is still inappropriate but we will have a silent disco on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 6.30pm – 8.00pm**. The red carpet will be in place and food/juice will be provided as normal. Pupils can dress smart/casual for the event.

Teachers are also currently planning a fun activity week which will take place w/b 6<sup>th</sup> June and will include some exciting day trips. We also plan to have a summer service on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June, which may take place at St. George's Outreach Centre (formerly Glenburn Parish Church) or in the school hall, whichever is appropriate at the time.

We will issue an information letter for P7 parents once trips and activities have been finalised but hopefully this gives you some advance notice of what our intentions are for P7.

## **World Book Day**
