School Improvement Plan

Head Teacher gave an update on the SIP and Pupil Equity Fund.

- Increase attainment in Writing across the school, with particular focus on P4-P7.
 School is using a new programme called Talk for Writing which is hoped will improve writing as this has been impacted negatively since covid.
- Increase attainment in Reading across the school, with particular focus on P5 and P6. An available room has been revamped into a library space and it is hoped to invite parents in, in due course.
- Health and Wellbeing of all pupils will be tracked and measured to help us identify who
 requires support. A questionnaire/survey of pupils will identify gaps and inform planning.
- Increase parental involvement and engagement. Looking forward to opening the school doors to the community in terms of parents' night, assemblies etc.
- There has been a reduction in the Pupil Equity Fund however available money has been used for additional teaching staff to support learning and teach small groups across the school.
- The school will continue with supported study, subscriptions for Sumdog, IDL & Education City, breakfast club and will have support from Active School Coaches.
- As discussed at a previous meeting the school will begin to charge or ask for a contribution from parents when there is a school trip.

Education Manager's Visit

 A new Education Manager has been appointed to the school, Emma Henry. She is the Education Officer for the Gleniffer Cluster and will visit Langeraigs on 25th October to meet with staff and pupils.

Fundraising Events

After much discussion the following was agreed:

- A Halloween Disco will be offered to P1-3 then P4-7 if a DJ can be sourced within budget. Water, crisps and quench cups will be offered to children and £2 will be charged.
- Christmas Fayre will take place on Friday 2nd December. Mugs, mobile number prize draw. Arrangements to be agreed at the next meeting.
