Main Improvement Tasks for 2022/2023

- We will focus on increasing attainment in Writing across the school.
- Raising attainment in Reading across the school.
- Health and Wellbeing of all pupils will be tracked and measured over the course of the year, which will help us to identify who requires support.
- Increased parental involvement and engagement over the course of the school year.

Learning and Teaching

From the above, you will see that one of our main priorities this school session is to improve pupils' skills in writing. To help us with this, staff have been trained in using Talk for Writing, a writing pedagogy which many other Renfrewshire schools have also begun to use. The Talk for Writing approach enables children to read and write independently for a variety of audiences and purposes within different subjects. A key feature is that children internalise the language structures needed to write through 'talking the text', as well as close reading. The approach moves from dependence towards independence, with the teacher using shared and guided teaching to develop the ability in children to write creatively and powerfully. P1-P3 are currently using the strategies, with P4-P7 using them after the October holiday. We hope that the methods used will help improve pupils' skills and abilities with writing and you may want to ask your child how they are finding using them and if they are enjoying their writing more than before.

Tempest Photographer in School

The photographer will be in school on Tuesday 4th October to take individual/sibling photographs. Please ensure that children wear a white shirt and school tie.

Non-Uniform Day
