You Decide - Authority Initiative

Renfrewshire Council are providing people with an opportunity to have their say as to how a proportion of the budget is spent. Residents are being asked for ideas for local infrastructure projects for our community empowerment campaign called #YouDecide - with £1.2million available to be spent by communities.

So far, 2,800 ideas have been submitted and have been shortlisted into 115 feasible projects. Now they want schools to take part in the voting - that's teachers, school staff, pupils, parents and carers!

How to vote

You can vote at www.renfrewshire.gov.uk/YouDecide.

Enter your post code to see the projects in your local area - you can use the school post code if a pupil doesn't know theirs. You can then drag and drop the projects to rank them 1, 2, 3 and so on until there's none left - with number 1 going at the top. The projects with the most votes will be funded until the £75,000 for each of the 16 areas is allocated. **Voting will close on 11 December 2022** with the works to complete the projects will begin in early 2023.

We recognise that not everyone has online access, so voting in-person is available at local libraries and roadshows are taking place at key locations in towns and villages across Renfrewshire during the voting period - you can see where at www.renfrewshire.gov.uk/youdecide.
