Be assured, that over the course of the school year, pupils will cover the requisite range of skills and experiences and outcomes appropriate to their particular stage.

Games in P.E. - our days for P.E. are Monday and Tuesday.
Five a Day Fitness.

Expressive Arts

Exploration of wet and dry media through play.
Basic drama skills e.g. movement and role play.

Technologies

Cutting/sticking skills.

Religious & Moral Education

In term one, the children will focus on personal and social development such as turn taking, sharing and thinking of others. After the October break we will focus on the Nativity Story.

Science

Looking at the world beyond the Earth - the Sun, Moon & Stars.

Primary 1 Homework August 2023

Phonics:

Term 1 Homework will be issued on a Monday to be handed in on a Friday.

Each child will be given:

- a sound sheet to be coloured & for practice writing
- a sound booklet - to revise all the sounds covered.

Reading: After the October holiday your child will begin to bring a reading book home.

This should be read every night and brought into class for use every day.

Each child will be given:

- a reading book - to read Monday to Thursday.
- a homework diary - which will give details of reading to be done.
- a wordwall at the back of the diary to reinforce and revise key words.

Term 2 - Phonic homework will continue as term 1 until all 42 sounds have been covered.

Reading homework will continue as term 1 with the child progressing through the reading scheme at a pace suited to their learning.

Term 3 - Phonic homework will continue until all 42 sounds have been covered. Revision of all sounds covered using sound book will continue. Double sound worksheets will be given.

Reading homework will continue as term 2 with the child progressing through the reading scheme at a pace suited to their learning.

Maths: Your child will bring home workbooks relevant to their class learning. Two pages will be issued per week.

The main topics will be covered as follows:

Term 1: Recognition, formation and counting of numbers to 12. 2D Shape recognition.

Term 2: Addition and subtraction within 10.

Term 3: Time, weight, money and measurement will be covered.

Revision and activity worksheets to reinforce work covered will be given home.
