<u>Primary 1 Homework</u>

Term 1

Phonics: Homework will be issued on two days of the week - Monday and Wednesday.

Each child will be given: - sound sheets - to be coloured and letter written.

- a sound booklet - to revise all the sounds covered.

Maths: Homework will be issued on Tuesday and Thursday for all terms.

Your child will be given booklets with the page number to be completed written on the inside page. Please sign when complete and return it.

<u>Reading:</u> Homework will be issued on four days of the week - Monday to Thursday - after the October holiday.

Each child will be given: - a reading book - to read Monday to Thursday.

- a homework diary which will give details of reading to be done.
- wordwall at the back of the marker with highlighted words to reinforce and revise key words.

Term 2

Phonics - Phonic homework will continue as term 1 until all 42 sounds have been covered.

Term 3 onwards

Phonic homework will continue until all 42 sounds have been covered. Revision of all sounds covered using sound book will continue. Double sound worksheets will be given. Reading homework will continue as term 2 with the child progressing through the reading scheme at a pace suited to their learning.

Maths

The following are the main topics covered during the year.

Term 1: Recognition, formation and counting of numbers to 12.

Term 2: Addition and subtraction within 12.

<u>Term 3</u>: Time, weight, money and measurement will be covered.

Revision worksheets to reinforce work covered.
