Our School Aims

The aims of Langcraigs Primary School are:

- Promote a positive ethos which reflects our five core values.
- Encourage and enable all our pupils to be Successful Learners, Confident Individuals, Responsible Citizens and Effective Contributors.
- Provide a broad relevant coherent and progressive curriculum which offers our pupils challenge, choice and enjoyment.
- Provide a range of teaching and learning approaches which take account of individual needs.
- Provide equal opportunities for all our pupils.
- Promote healthy lifestyles.
- Provide appropriate resources which support learning and teaching.
- Provide our community with a welcoming, efficient and effective school.

Progress of Main Improvement Tasks 2022/2023

- **Increase attainment in Writing across the school.**
All classes started to implement a new approach to Writing in the form of Talk for Writing, which is being used by most schools in Renfrewshire. By June 2023, attainment in Writing increased in almost all stages throughout the school, compared with data from June 2022.

- **Increase attainment in Reading across the school.**
Renewed connections with the school's local library and a greater emphasis on promoting reading for pleasure by pupils, resulted in increased attainment in Reading at most stages throughout the school
- **Health and Wellbeing of all pupils.**
Effective use of the Glasgow Motivation and Wellbeing Profiling tool resulted in pupils receiving appropriate interventions to support their social and emotional wellbeing.
- **Increased parental involvement and engagement.**
Parents were able to attend class assemblies, open afternoons, parent/teacher meetings and health evenings, which provided greater opportunities for parents to, once again, become involved in their child's learning journey.

Main Improvement Tasks for 2023/2024

- **Continue to focus on increasing attainment in Writing across the school.**
- **Continue to raise attainment in Reading across the school.**
- **Embed new Getting It Right for Every Child (GIRFEC) policies and procedures.**
- **Develop consistent approaches to managing and using information (cluster priority).**
