Talk for Writing

This term we will again have a fiction and non-fiction block of Talk for Writing. We will be focusing on internalising our new story, learning about the new vocabulary and special literary techniques (figures of speech, descriptive language, varied sentence length). This term for Primary 1 we will also be expecting children to begin to write a sentence. For Primary 2 we are expecting children to independently write a sentence and develop ambition in their sentence structure.
