Subtraction and addition within 10.

Numbers to 20. Number names to 10.

Language

Continue to work on the 42 sounds in the English language with the focus on double sounds.

Continue to work on blending sounds to sound out words.

Begin sentence construction with knowledge of capital letters and full stops.

Continue to work on letter formation and layout of writing.

Talk for Writing - This term we will again have a fiction and non-fiction block of Talk for Writing. We will be focusing on internalising our new story, learning about the new vocabulary and special literary techniques (figures of speech, descriptive language, varied sentence length).

This term for Primary 1 we will also be expecting children to begin to write a sentence.
