

P7A - The Great War Homework Project: Thursday 10th October 2024

We are giving you a selection of homework activities and you must choose an option or options which total to at least 10 points. As we are giving you a lot of time to complete this homework, we expect good quality work. Please support your child in furthering their understanding of our 'WWI' topic. The homework has been designed to allow a degree of flexibility. All children have access to school resources and facilities including the ICT Suite (including at lunchtime homework club). As ever, comments from parents/ guardians regarding the homework are welcomed.

Develop your creativity:

- ◆ Create your own superhero. Base it on a person who played a key role in WWI. (2 point)
- ◆ Create a detailed 3D model of a WWI trench and be able to talk about the features. (5 points)
- ◆ Research and write an account of a heroic deed during WW1. (3 points)

Extend your research skills:

- ◆ Talk to your family or research and find out who was involved in WWI. What were their roles? Find photos and other special objects. (2 points)
- ◆ What is your nearest 'local' army regiment or unit? What is their regimental badge? Create a fact file of key facts. (4 points)

Explore your mathematical skills:

Imagine you and two friends wish to visit London to attend Remembrance Day activities at The Cenotaph, can you calculate:

- ◆ How much would it cost to travel to London by train? (1 point)
- ◆ How much the London underground would cost? (1 point)
- ◆ What would the cost be to stay in a hotel for two nights? (1 point)
- ◆ Calculate the distance you would travel if you visited London and how long would it take? (1 point)
- ◆ Create a timetable to help you. (2 points)



Explore:

- ◆ Where is your local War memorial? Create a map of the location and draw a detailed picture. (2 point)
- ◆ Visit a local museum – take notes on any WWI artefacts there. (5 points)
- ◆ Explore with an adult the animations on BBC Bitesize WW1 website. What have you learned? Create your own animation or story. (4 points)
