### Language

- **Talk for Writing** - Focus will be on Setting writing using model text Aliens Landing  
Skills will include- Hooking the reader, the 5 senses, personification and  
Internalising new story  
Learning new vocabulary and special literary techniques (use of:  
repetition, empty words and rhetorical questions.)  
Applying these new skills to write an extended piece of writing.
- **Oxford Reading Scheme** - continue with core reading books being read at home and in school, with associated reading activities completed in class.
- **Nelson Spelling** - weekly spelling rules with spelling test on Fridays
- **Topic**: Topic related writing, comprehension and preparation for solo talk on a different country.
- **Grammar** - Organising work into paragraphs, word types (verbs, adverbs, adjectives) and sentence structure.

- **Comprehension** - Poetic techniques, information reading and understanding the text through Nelson Comprehension.
- **Solo Talk**- Solo talk based on our topic of Around the World. Pupils will prepare a brief talk about life in another country. (More information to follow)
