Dear Parent/Carer,

Below is an outline of what your child will be learning about this term. There are eight main curricular areas and due to the flexible nature of Curriculum for Excellence, some areas may just be touched upon or may not be covered at all during a particular term. Therefore, do not be concerned if there is little or no information for a particular curricular area below. Be assured, that over the course of the school year, pupils will cover the requisite range of skills and experiences and outcomes appropriate to their particular stage.

Mathematics:

Octagons group - This term we will complete 2nd Level; starting at Topic 13 and working on Number, Probability, Money (Financial Education), Scale and Area, Expressions and Equations (including BODMAS) and Measure (Weight and Volume).

Triangles group - This term we will continue on 2nd Level; starting at Topic 10 and working on 3D Shape, Time (Duration), Multiplication & Division, Fractions and Decimals.

Language: We will continue working at 2nd Level and working to improve our spelling, reading (via homework, library and topic work), listening & talking, and making notes from various sources (including preparations for the end of term service). We will continue with grammar, speech marks, sentence structure and in 'Talk for Writing' we will be developing our skills using fiction/non-fiction. Development of our understanding, analysing and evaluating skills in literacy will be continued in language work, as well as across the curriculum.

Science/Social Studies topic: Mrs Burns will cover photosynthesis and the water cycle - both science concepts which were discussed by the Culzean Castle Rangers during our recent visit. We will link our learning to other areas of the curriculum including literacy, art and ICT, and study 'topical science' via Reach-out Reporter from Twig. We will be having Citizenship Group activities across the school this term.

Health & Wellbeing: In P.E., we will be undertaking a programme of 'P7 Sports Champion' events and preparation for the school sports day. We will also be learning social dancing with a view to the Ceilidh in June. We will continue with the PATHS programme, as well as experiencing a variety of H&WB activities during Langcraig Health Week. We will be covering Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood Education (RSHP) in Term 3 - letters will be sent to parent/carers around the end of April (before commencement) outlining what will be covered. We will also be undertaking enhanced P7/S1 transition activities with Gleniffer High School.

Expressive Arts: We will be incorporating many aspects of Expressive Arts as part of our preparation for, and delivery of, the end of year service and Ceilidh.

Technologies: We will continue developing our use of ICT skills and linking these to other curricular areas such as Literacy, Numeracy and our Science/Social Studies topics.

Religious & Moral Education: Pupils will be asked to research three religions of their choice and produce a short report on them, outlining the core beliefs and values of each.

Modern Languages: In French, we will be continuing to learn and revise words and phrases, including numbers, body parts, classroom objects and food.
