Thursday 19th June – Ceilidh

The Primary 7 Ceilidh will take place in the school gym hall 6.00pm-8.00pm.

As the Ceilidh is a special occasion, we would ask that pupils make every effort to come in formal dress where possible e.g. kilt, shirt and tie, dress, suit.

The dance finishes at 8.00pm with 'Auld Lang Syne' and parents will be invited into the hall at around 7.50pm to join us for this. Any limousines/party buses should be arranged to arrive for 8.00pm at the earliest.

We are allowing pupils the opportunity to take appropriate photographs on mobile phones before and after the dance, but they must not be used once the ceilidh gets underway. If caught using a mobile phone during the hours of 6.00pm-8.00pm or in an inappropriate way, pupils have been told that their mobile phone will be confiscated and returned to their parents at the end of the evening.
