Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

We are delighted to share that Langcraigs received 2 awards in recognition of the hard work around digital learning that goes on across the school. Following a validation meeting, we were awarded the 'Digital Wellbeing Award' and the 'Equitable Creative Coding Award'. We couldn't have done this without Miss Colquhoun's dedication or the hard work of our Digital Leaders.

The Digital Wellbeing Award and Equitable Creative Coding Award are nationally recognised and are awarded to schools that work towards developing pupils' skills in using technology safely, responsibly and creatively. At Langcraigs, we explore digital citizenship, online safety, coding and computational thinking, while promoting inclusion, equity and positive digital experiences for all.
