
# Mossvale EYC & Primary School Parent Newsletter 30<sup>th</sup> October 2020

# PRIMARY 1 REGISTRATION

If your child's birthday falls between 1<sup>st</sup> March 2020 and 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021 you will need to enrol your child for school next week.
