## PARENT COVID SAFETY GUIDELINES

### School;

Daily ongoing cleaning.

Minimum adults in each class.

Staff wear face coverings in all communal areas including playground but are not required to wear them when teaching infant children which has been in place since before Christmas. Children will follow the usual daily handwashing routines they followed prior to the holidays. We will ensure good ventilation and children will have a longer morning break to allow them time to be outside and adjust to being back in school.

Staff are also now self-testing twice a week.

#### Parents:

Only 1 parent to drop off/pick up children.

Every adult in the playground must wear a mask.

All adults keep 2 m apart and do not meet in groups.

Parents encouraged not to car share.

If you have any symptoms please self-isolate.

We have now had confirmation that all our pupils will return on Monday  $15^{th}$  March. As there will again be a larger number of people in the playground we are having to stagger our pupil entry times.

P1, P2/1, P3/2, P4, P5 and P7 will be arriving to school for 9 am and we ask that you do not come too early and leave straight away if you have a P1-3 child. Older children can be collected from outside the playground.

P4/3 and P6 will be coming in at 8.50 am.

Can you please return on that day any IT equipment that was borrowed as we will need this is school for the pupils returning.
