<u>Meet and Greet</u> – To be done every morning and at the end of every day. Each teacher to decide the best place to do their meet and greet, what they would like to do and if they want a sign for the children to point to first or not.



<u>Class Identity</u> - Each class to come up with their own class name. Ideas to come from the children and vote on their favourite.



<u>Family Wall</u> – At home, people have photos of family members in frames. This is trying to recreate this. Children can bring in any photo of family, animals etc. with or without themselves in the photo.



<u>Be Myself Photos</u> – Outside each classroom should be photos of the children in the class posing in a way that represents them. Can be displayed in any way you wish.



<u>Calm Corner</u> – Have an area in your room for a child to go to if they need some space or to calm down. The area could have mindfulness colouring, fidget tools and signs showing ways to calm down.



<u>Fist of 5</u> – Ask children to give fist of 5 in the morning to check in. Explain each number – 3 is okay maybe tired. If 1 or 2 take time to check in with that child.
