Registration of Infant Beginners in Primary Schools Session 2020-21

Children who reach 5 years of age between 1 March 2020 and 28 February 2021 inclusive should be registered in their catchment area school as follows:

Pupils whose surnames begin with initials A to L should be registered on **Wednesday 15 January 2020**. Pupils whose surnames begin with initials M to Z should be registered on **Thursday 16 January 2020**.

Registration will take place between 1pm and 3pm on each day.

If you are unsure of your catchment school, please contact the school office staff who will be happy to help.

Parents should produce their child's birth certificate, and two proofs of residence, **which must include** council tax notice for the property **or** proof that you have registered for council tax at that property, and a letter from your solicitor confirming that missives have been concluded or a rent book for rented property, tenancy agreement or a mortgage/bank statement. **Original documents must be produced.**

If you have any questions about registering your child please contact the school office.

The school are hosting a **Walkround** for parents of children who may be joining Primary 1 in Newmains Primary in August 2020. This will take place on **Thursday 9 January 2020 from 2.15 pm**.

Inclement Weather

The weather is now becoming colder and wetter. All children should be suitably dressed with a waterproof coat and sturdy shoes or boots. Children will only be kept in school at playtime and lunchtime when the weather is extremely poor. At all other times children will be outside playing and as mentioned should be suitably dressed.

In the event of icy, snowy weather the janitor will ensure that there is at least one path from the infant entrance to the Primary 1 door. There is also a path from the main entrance to the office. If the playground is really icy the main entrance gate will be closed and all children will enter the school through the Primary 1 doors, as we did on Monday this week. If it is still very icy at the end of the day, the children will also leave through the Primary 1 exit. I know this takes longer and I would ask parents/carers to be patient when waiting for your child/children. Thank you once again for your support in ensuring the safety of our children.

Information in Emergencies

We make every effort to maintain a full educational service, but on some occasions circumstances arise which lead to disruption. Schools may be affected by, for example severe weather, temporary interruption of transport, power failures or difficulties of fuel supply. In such cases, we will do all we can to let you know about the details of closure and reopening. We will keep in touch using letters, e-mail and text messaging, school app, notices in local shops, churches and community centres and on the school and council's websites, announcements in the press and on local radio.

To help us keep you informed it is important that you make sure we have the most up to date emergency contact information for your family.
