Families who are entitled to free school meals and clothing grants will receive a payment from the local authority. I believe the first payment has already been paid to eligible families. For children in P1-P3 the payment will be made to those families who receive a clothing grant as it is based on income grounds.

As children use our Google Classrooms it is important that they follow the guidance sent out last week regarding the local authority Acceptable Usage Policy. The key points are noted below - this will ensure that our children stay safe.

- I will always be polite and will not use bad language
- I will remember that anything I do can usually be traced back to me
- I will not access, create, store or distribute files that could be thought of as offensive or indecent, or that harasses or insults others



- I will not share my personal details or any personal information about other people (home address, phone number etc) in emails, on the internet or with other people
- I will only send emails to people I know, or my teacher knows
- I will not arrange to meet other people I talk to online
