Transition for P7 and new P1 children

P7 will be invited to come to the school in small groups for an hour on 18 May 2020. We are currently working out a timetable for the children to come along. We will also have a small presentation ceremony in the groups as we say goodbye to our children. More details will be sent to families shortly.

There will also be a chance to visit Renfrew High School for an hour on one of the following days - 19, 22 and 23 June 2020. Information will be sent home to parents shortly with your child's date and time for a visit to Renfrew High School. We are also working with other High Schools for children not going to Renfrew HS and we will send information when available.

Children who will be joining P1 in August 2020 will be invited to visit the school on one of the following dates - 19, 22 and 23 June 2020. They will come in small groups, with one adult, to meet their teacher and have a look in the classrooms. We will send details of date and time to all families early next week. Senior staff will be available to answer any questions parents may have. We look forward to meeting you. We have also asked parents to sign up for Seesaw to help communication.

School Uniform

I know that parents are thinking about uniforms for next session and as children will spend a lot of time learning in the outdoor environment we are changing our school uniform. Children will continue to wear part of their uniform in the form of a polo shirt and school sweatshirt or grey jumper/cardigan. We want all of our children to connect with our school as a Newmains

pupil. The change will be that the children do not need to wear grey trousers or skirt or dress. We would recommend that all children wear jogging bottoms and training shoes each day. We realise that if children are outside clothes may need to be washed more often.

All parents will receive information about arrangements for next session before we leave in June 2020.
