Dropping off and collecting children

Thank you for your support in our new times for dropping off and collecting children. I feel our new times are better with regard to congestion outside the school and for children arriving in the class. We will continue to review the situation. We spoke to all of our children about how they are feeling about being back at school. The response was very positive with most children happy to be back and glad to see their friends. Some children pointed out that they are worried about the number of parents at the exit gate as they leave at the end of the day and the amount of cars parked outside the school. I would ask parents to leave plenty of room at the exit gate and I would appreciate parents not parking outside the school. Thank you for your support.

Safety

We continue to work towards following the government guidelines with respect to keeping a 2m distance between children and staff. Our day cleaner clean common areas regularly throughout the day. Children are also getting used to washing their hands and cleaning tables.

If a child presents with COVID symptoms, they will be taken to a designated area and parents/carers will be contacted to take them home. Staff will follow all COVID procedures while keeping children calm. We would ask that you update us on their condition after 24 hours.

Guidelines regarding face covering was sent out to parents yesterday. It will affect those children who take the school bus. It is still personal choice for children and staff as to whether they wear a face covering in the classroom.

Outdoor Learning

In line with current Government guidance, all children in school will be involved in outdoor learning every day. Children will complete PE outdoors on the following days:

Our School Sports Coordinator will be working with all classes on Thursdays from August to October. Andrew Mitchell will follow a timetable and work with 5 classes when he visits each Thursday. We are pleased that we can continue to work in partnership in this way.

Children should come dressed appropriately to be outside in all weather. Children should wear wellies and a good outdoor waterproof jacket with a hood. Children can bring indoor shoes in their school bag. We will continue to follow Government guidelines in relation to Physical Education and outdoor learning and adapt if anything changes.

If you choose to download the Google Classroom app, you will need to create a new Google account with your child's GLOW username and the ending @re.glow.scot. e.g. gw20bloggsjoe@re.glow.scot or gw15clarksam@re.glow.scot.

We will send a jotter home so that children can complete their homework. The jotters should **not** be returned to the school. The work can be uploaded on to the Google Classroom.
