



#### Absence information

Your child will soon receive an envelope which contains a number of important forms to complete so that our records are up-to-date. #### Breakfast Club

The breakfast club is open Monday to Friday from 8.20 am. Children should not arrive at the school until 8.20 am where there are staff to supervise them. The cost of breakfast club is 50p paid via parent pay. Please bring your child through the school playground to the front entrance as the carpark at that time can be busy with staff cars arriving and deliveries. If at any time you do not require your space or wish to reduce the number of days, please let the office staff know as there is a waiting list.

## Drop off and Pick up

Thank you for following the guidance around drop off and pickup. Our pupil questionnaire last session highlighted the benefits for the pupils in reducing the number of adults in the playground. Parents and carers of P1-3 are welcome to wait either at the pencils in the P1 playground or behind the painted pickup line in the P2 playground. Parents and carers of P4-7 should collect outside the school. A reminder that no dogs are allowed in the playground as per Renfrewshire Council policy for all schools and nurseries and only cars accessing the disabled parking spaces are permitted in the staff carpark.

## Medication

Medication cannot be either self-administered or given voluntarily to your child by school staff without prior written agreement. The forms can be obtained from the school office. Only medication prescribed by the doctor can be administered by staff and then only if it is **not** the first dose. The medicine should be brought to school with the pharmacy administration label on it which includes the child's name and date of birth.

#### Communication

We have made significant improvements with communication over the last year however results from the parent questionnaire identified the need to streamline the number of platforms. Going forward we will be using seesaw as our main communication tool which includes regular photographs and updates about your child, homework and whole school announcements. The school app will cease use by the September weekend to allow a transition period.

The school website, Twitter and Facebook pages remain operational to share successes and general messages/information about the school - please make sure you are following us.

Seesaw is a very effective communication tool however if there is something very personal, important or time sensitive you wish the school to know about then please continue to phone the school office as these messages are passed on immediately whereas teaching staff access seesaw when they are able during the teaching day.

## Parental engagement and involvement

Responses to the parent/career questionnaire at the end of last term were very positive and noted many of the developments and changes made recently, in particular opportunities for parents and carers to be involved in the life of the school. We have already held a successful *Tea and Tissues* event on the first day for Primary 1 parents where they had the chance to meet and chat.

We will be reintroducing the Volunteer Programme - Miss Gillon will send information out in the next few weeks if you are interested in being part of that.

Parents and carers are invited to the Meet the Teacher event on 24th August and Parent Interviews this session will be face-to-face in school, on 12th October.
