Learning Journals and Achievements

We have been getting to know our new children and putting some work into their new Learning Journals. We ask for any outstanding 'All About Me' books to be returned as soon as possible. The journals will be accessible at various points throughout the year. We would also like to recognise any achievements your child makes outside of nursery. This can include anything from dancing or swimming certificates to learning to ride a bike or sleeping in their own bed. Let your child's keyworker know the next time you are in and we can include this in their Learning Journal.

COVID – 19

There is still a requirement to follow the safety measures around physical distancing of adults and we respectfully ask that you continue to adhere to the following when dropping off/collecting their children:

- Keep **1m** physical distancing
- **Wear a face covering** while waiting at the gate and entering the school grounds



If your child is under the weather, please only bring them if you feel they are well enough to attend.

If your child displays any of the following symptoms, please do not bring them to nursery and arrange for them to have a test:

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss, or change, to sense of taste and/or smell

Session 2022/2023

Children who reach 5 years of age between 1 March 2022 and 28 February 2023 inclusive should be registered for education in their catchment school as follows:

You must register your child in only one school, either the denominational or non-denominational school for your area.
