Staff members will be on the doors all at times to direct parents to correct entrance/exit. This will enable parents to see ELCC and communicate with their child's keyworker.

ELCC Graduation



The ELCC graduation for our pre-school children will be held on Friday 24th June at 9.30am. All children will be given a t-shirt in their group colour for them to wear on the day. Please ensure your child arrives at the ELCC wearing the t-shirt. Each child will be issued with two tickets as we can only accommodate a certain number of guests in the main hall, however, should you require any more, please speak to Linda or Natalie and your name will be put in the ballot for an extra ticket. During the graduation ceremony the children will receive a certificate and a school tie. After the ceremony parents are welcome to come back to the ELCC playroom or outdoor area (weather permitting) for some cake and refreshments.

In the afternoon the ELCC will be having a fun day with activities such as face painting, a bouncy castle, and some end of term treats!



Parent Conversations and Transfer of Information

Our pre-school children will receive a Transfer of Information report for moving to Primary One. Parents will be given the opportunity to read and make a comment and discuss anything they would like the Primary One teacher to know, ensuring a smooth transition from ELCC to school. Your child will also be given the opportunity to comment. The reports for children going to Woodlands Primary will be available from week beginning Monday 16th May and for children going to Our Lady of Peace Primary, week beginning Monday 6th June.

Our ante-preschool children will receive a telephone call from their child's keyworker to discuss your child's progress to date. The phone calls will take place from the week beginning Monday 13th June.

My Body Belongs to Me

The ELCC staff have undergone training in Early Protective Messages and will be implementing the guidance throughout the term and beyond. The training was part of Child Protection to support staff and parents when using language with children to name private body parts. As part of the Curriculum for Excellence it is important for children in early years to learn the correct names for body parts to ensure there is a common language that children have permission to use that is accurate. With the hopes for sunny weather in mind we ask parents/carers to **apply sun-cream to their child before coming to the ELCC**. You can leave a bottle of sun-cream in ELCC for staff to re-apply, when necessary, over the course of the day.
