
Learning Intentions: In this exercise you are going to look at a drawing of a pillow made by an artist called **Albert Durer**. He was famous for the accurate way in which he drew the world around him. In this drawing he used a pen and ink to make the marks. Albert Durer made this drawing in 1493, but it looks like something we could find in our houses today. You are going to try and copy this drawing as accurately as you can. You will need to look closely at the way he makes the lines curve to suggest the folds in the pillow

Find out 5 facts about Albert Durer and write them in your sketchbook
