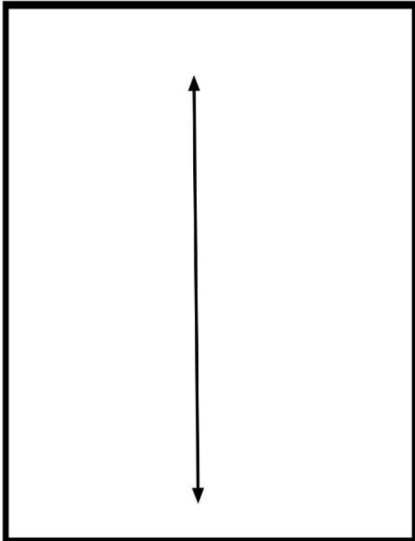


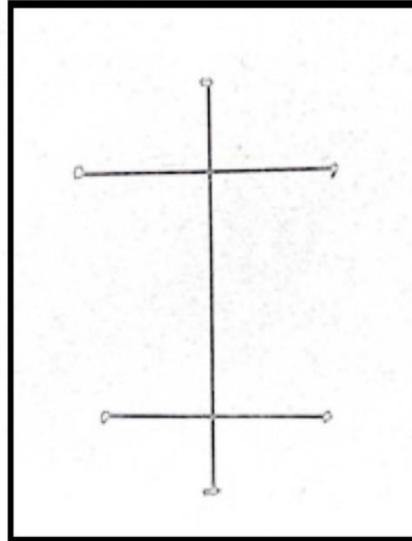
ELLIPSES AND PERSPECTIVE

Learning intentions: When we look at a cylindrical object, such as a mug, the top appears to be oval in shape. This is known as an ellipse. Draw your favourite mug from home. Sit the mug in front of you and follow the step by step guide to help you to plan, draw and shade your mug.

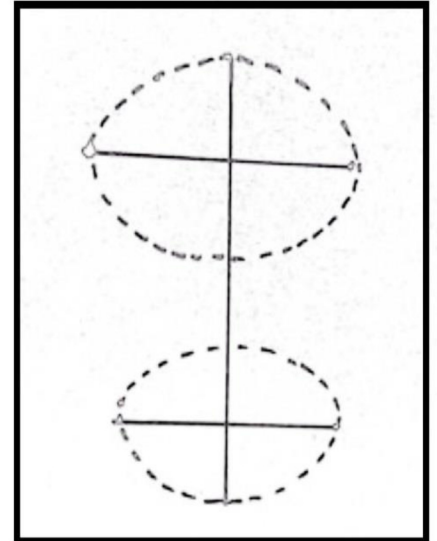
Remember to draw your own mug and to carefully observe it before drawing.



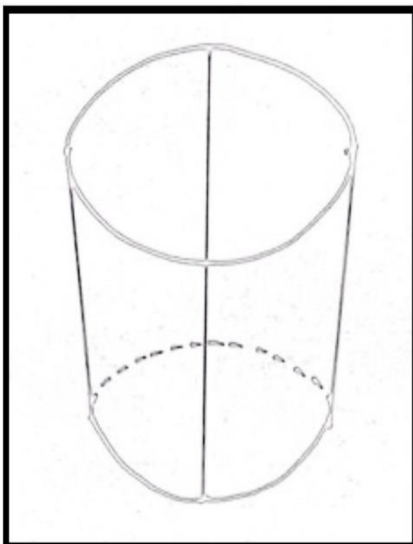
Draw a light vertical line to mark the centre of symmetry and height.



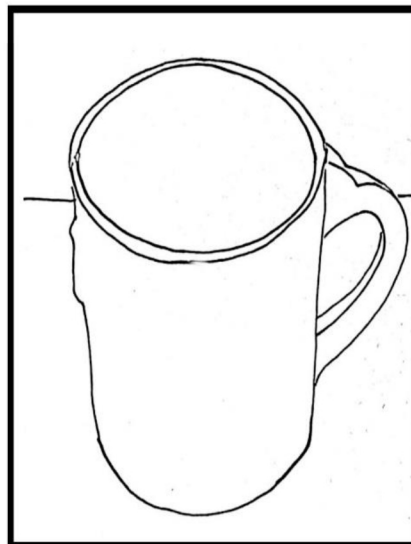
Draw a horizontal line to mark the width of the mug. Remember the width may change.



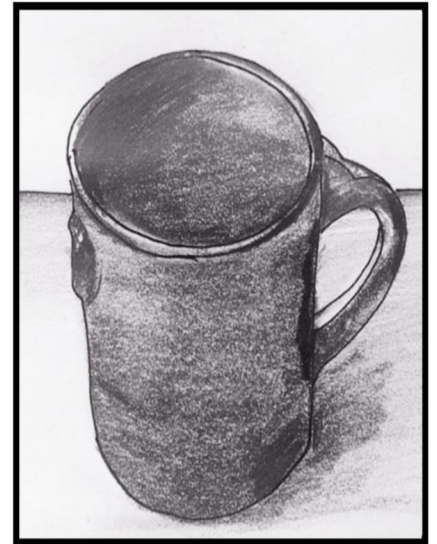
Next mark in depth and width of the oval as you see it at the top. Do the same at the bottom.



Now draw in the two sides of the mug.



Next add in the handle and any other detail you can see (lettering, images). Remember the mug has a thickness!



Finally shade the mug to show the direction of light, highlights and form.
