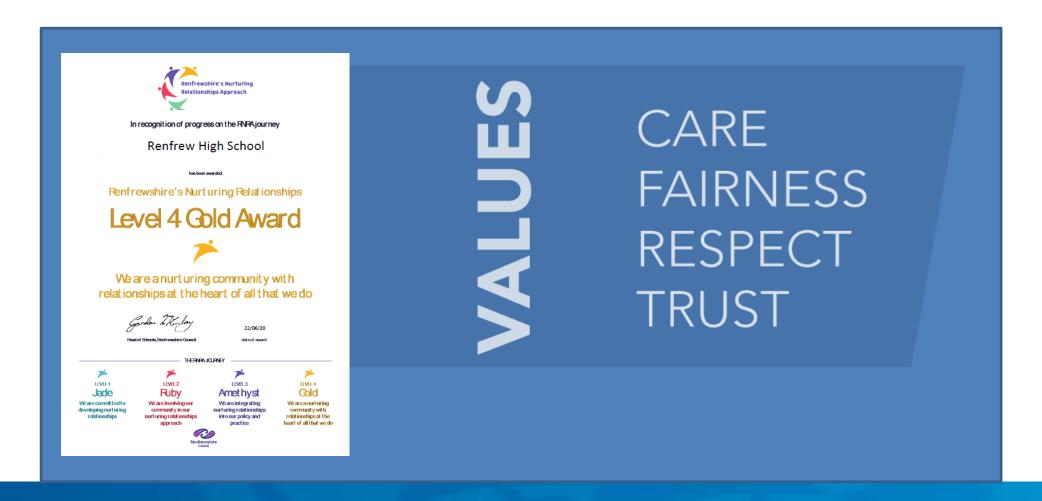

### **Expectations**
