

# RELATIONSHIPS, SEXUAL HEALTH AND PARENTHOOD (RSHP) EDUCATION: A new national teaching and learning resource for Scotland



A new national RSHP online teaching and learning resource is now available at <https://rshp.scot/>. This provides a comprehensive set of learning activities for teaching staff in all schools and early years establishments, as well as informal learning settings. The resource will assist with the delivery of high quality, up-to-date and engaging age and stage appropriate RSHP education for children and young people across the entire 3-18-year-old age range of Curriculum for Excellence. This new resource is also designed to be inclusive for learners with mild to moderate additional support for learning needs.

Funded and developed by a partnership of local authorities and health boards, with advice from Education Scotland and the Scottish Government.

The resource has drawn together and updated the best RSHP learning activities being delivered in Scotland and compliments these with a new set of activities designed to cover existing gaps. The resource's content will be updated on a regular basis to ensure it continues to meet the changing learning needs of children and young people in today's society.
