MAKE IT ONE PAGE

When you're young keep it 1 page, extend to 2 when you've had several jobs.



EDUCATION

Include the school/college attended and your most recent qualifications first.



SKILLS

Only include relevant skills to the job, e.g. Good with IT, driving license, any achievements.





PERSONAL INFORMATION

The title - 'Your Name' CV. Your name, contact details and a profile statement/ personal summary.



WORK EXPERIENCE

Include the most recent first & any voluntary work. Include employer, dates, your role and responsibilities.



HOBBIES/INTERESTS

Include what you are passionate about, e.g. photography, cadets, climbing munros.

Always tell the truth. If you lie there is always the chance of being found out.

Don't use fancy fonts or colours. Try to keep it in a clean and simple format.
