Learning Opportunities

Our priority for our children and young people is to be happy and healthy. We continue to focus on the health and wellbeing of our children. By using the Renfrewshire Nurturing Approach and (RICE) Renfrewshire Inclusive Community Environment we aim to ensure that all of our children feel safe and supported in school. We continue to focus on Literacy and Numeracy across the school and making sure that they are making progress in these areas.

Within the Senior Phase we will have an increased focus of Developing Young Workforce and looking at job opportunities within the local community.

Pupil Equity Fund

Our Pupil Equity Fund has funded drama sessions with Jordan Blackwood. In addition to this we have Music Therapy from Nordoff Robbins 3 times a week and Hear my Music twice a week. We continue to access Castle Semple twice a week for the Senior Phase and have recently appointed two staff members to develop links and create employment opportunities through the Development Young Workforce.

Parental Involvement

With the Covid restrictions now easing we look forward to welcoming our parents and partners back into the school. We are currently having a waking group that meet every Monday at 10am. As well as this there are a group of parents that meet on a Thursday in the Parents room, everyone is welcome. All classes are using Learning Journals as a form of communication with parents. Please get in touch if you are having any difficulties accessing the platform. The children particularly enjoy when they see comments from their families when sharing their news at morning group. We have a particular focus on parental engagement and are working to provide opportunities for parents to engage in the life of the school.
